


CLIMATE


Geography and climate of Pakistan are extremely diverse.







EDUCATION

Education in Pakistan is overseen by the federal Ministry of Education and Provincial Governments.

- Pakistan provides free education to children age 5 to 16.
- Literacy rate varies from 100% to 20% between various parts of the country.



EDUCATION

Education in Pakistan is divided into SIX levels.

- Preschool: ages 3-5
- Primary: Grades one through five.
- Middle: Grades six through eight.
- High: Grades nine and ten.
- Intermediate: Grades eleven and twelve.
- University Programs: Undergraduate and Graduate degrees.

- Squash: Most decorated squash nation in the world with 17 World open championships.








NATIONAL HERITAGE
