Pakistan is part of South Asia

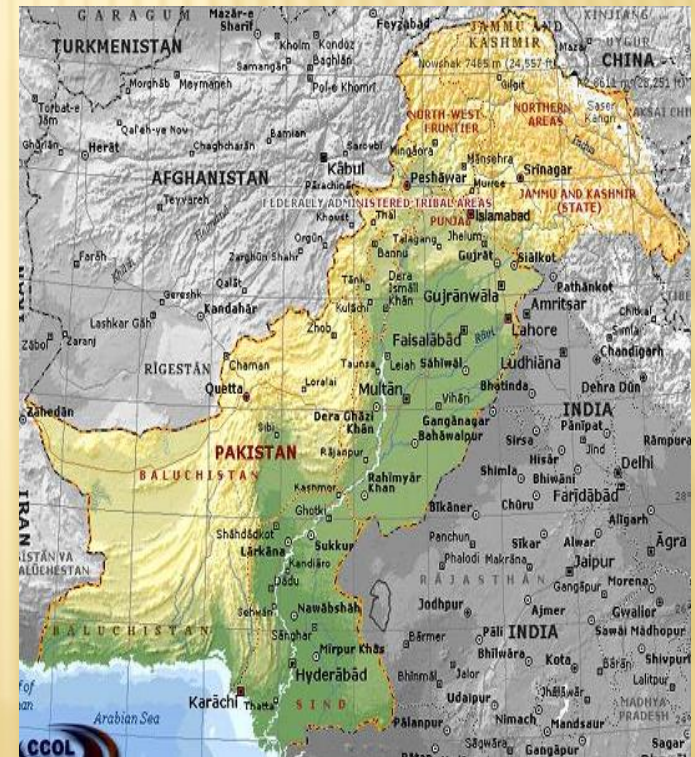
- **Neighboring with India, Afghanistan, Iran, and China.**

33rd Largest country in the world.

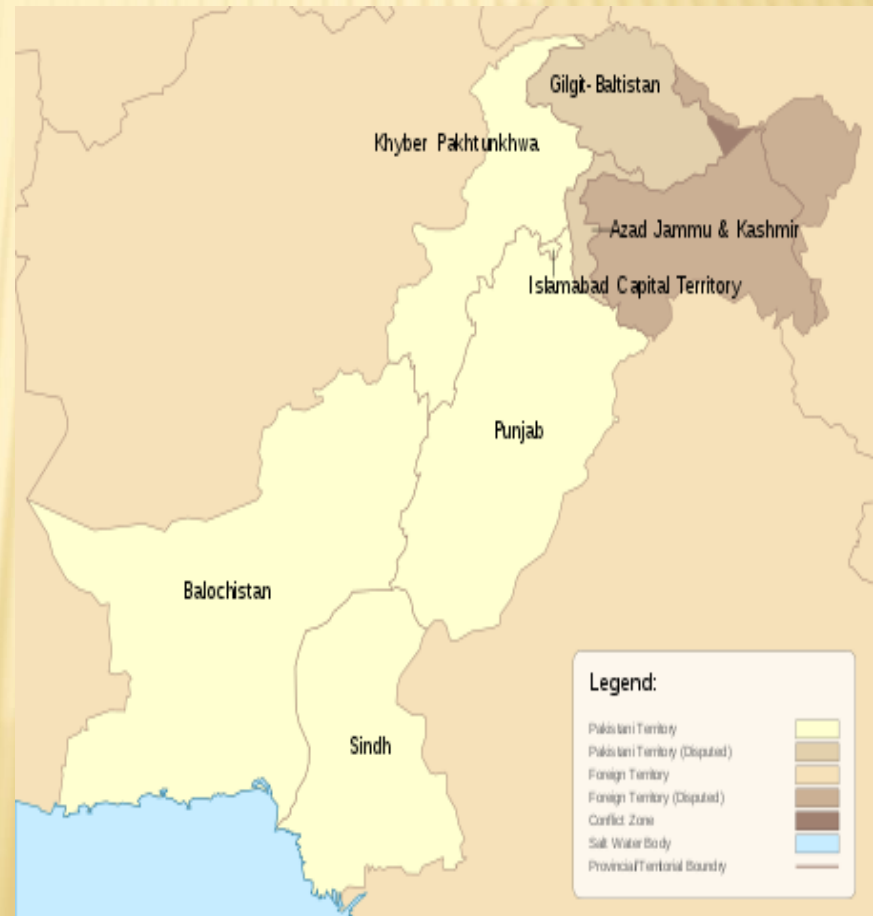
- With an area of **340,509 Square miles**

Subdivided into Seven main units.

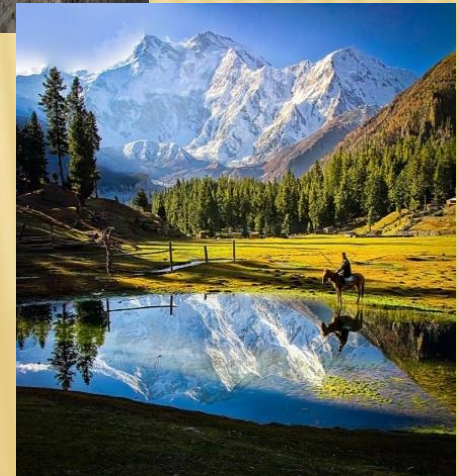

- Nanga Parbat , the killer mountain is the **9th** highest peak in the world, a height of **8,126 meters**.

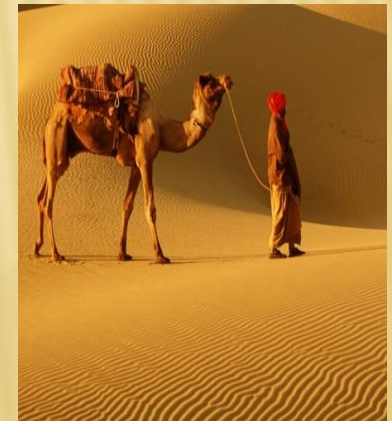
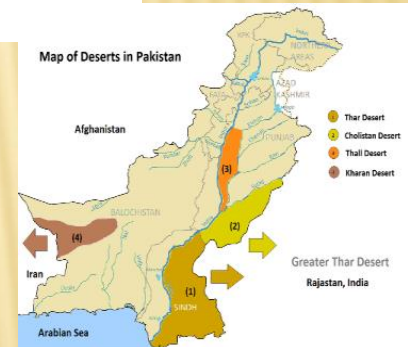

LANGUAGES

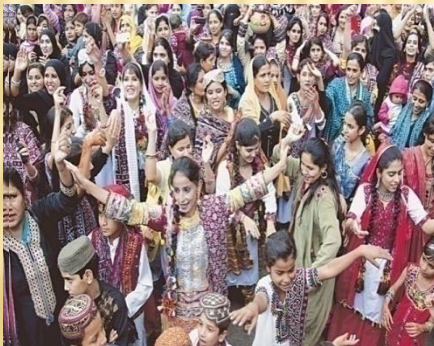
Pakistan is a home to more than Sixty different languages.

EDUCATION

Education in Pakistan is overseen by the federal Ministry of Education and Provincial Governments.

- **Pakistan provides free education to children age 5 to 16.**
- **Literacy rate varies from 100% to 20% between various parts of the country.**



EDUCATION

Education in Pakistan is divided into SIX levels.

- **Preschool:** ages 3-5
- **Primary:** Grades **one** through **five**.
- **Middle:** Grades **six** through **eight**.
- **High:** Grades **nine** and **ten**.
- **Intermediate:** Grades **eleven** and **twelve**.
- **University Programs:** **Undergraduate** and **Graduate** degrees.

- Mango orchards are mainly found in the provinces of **Punjab** and **Sindh**.

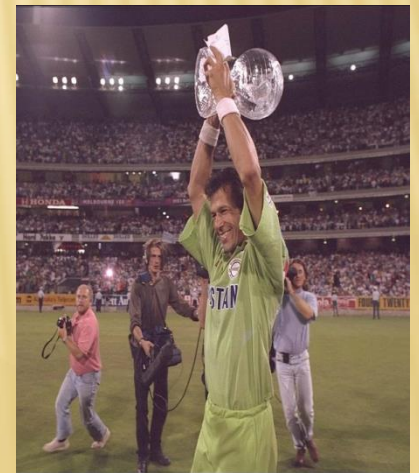

**Khewra Salt Mine is
Pakistan's largest, the

- It is also the **oldest salt** mine in the world.
- Its history dates back to its discovery by **Alexander's** troops in **320 BC**.
- It is producing more than **350,000 tons** per year.
