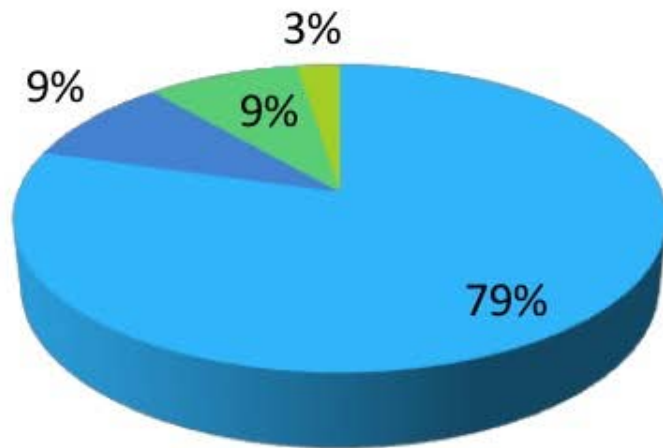




Brief Description: Demography

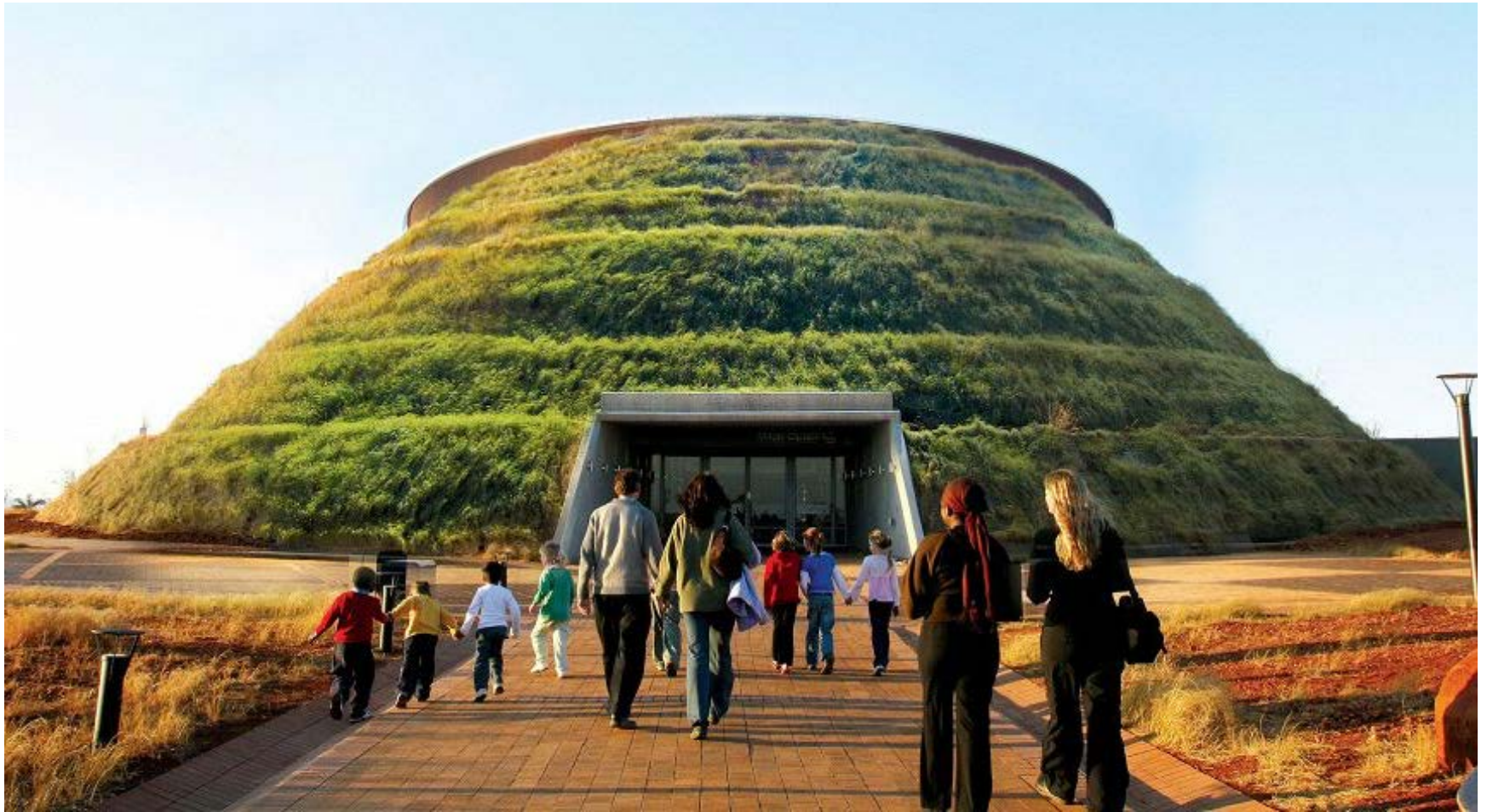

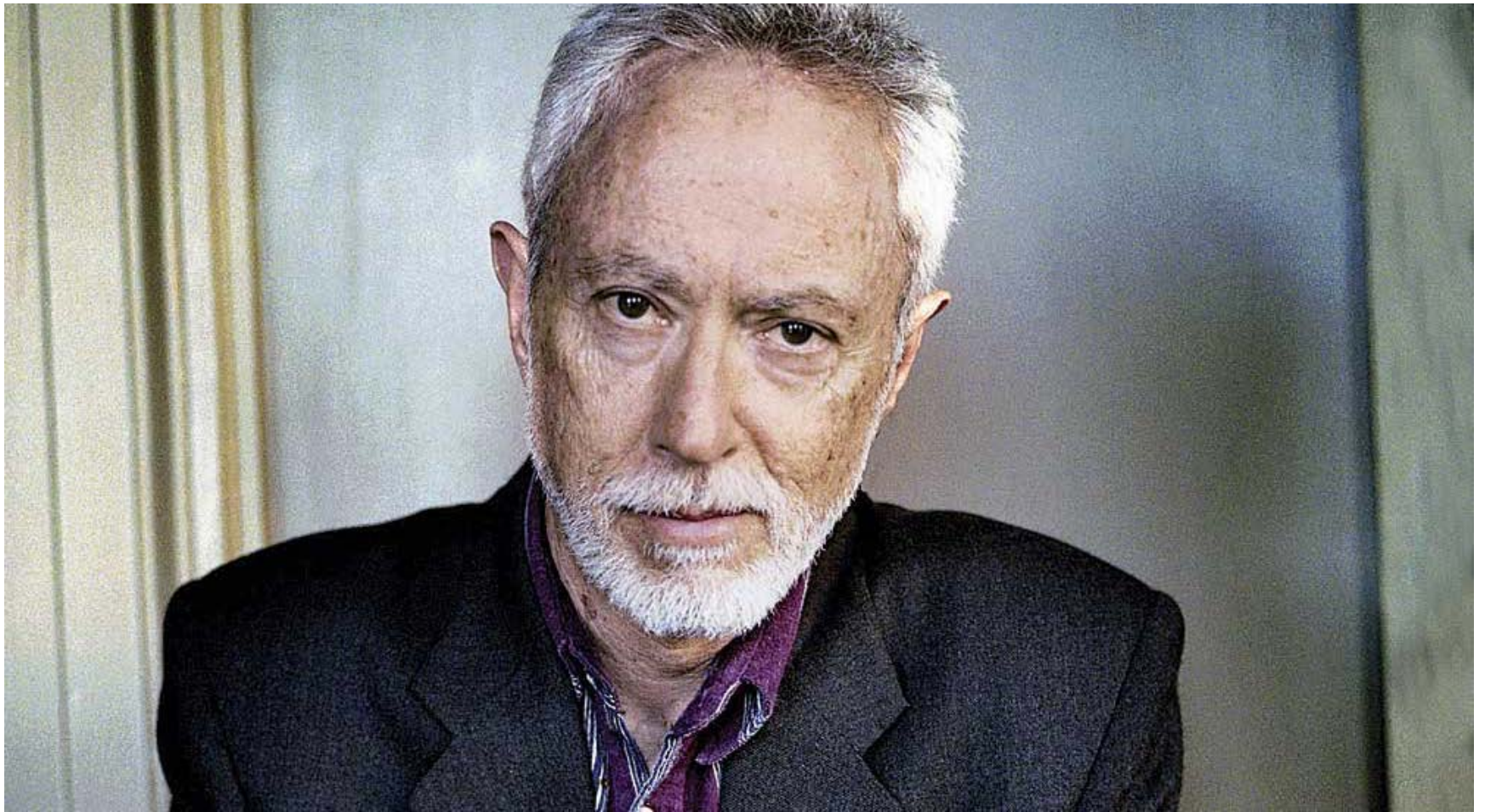
